A1 ICE CLASS

Polar yacht Explorer was originally built in 1994 as an oceanographic research vessel. The ship was recently renovated to reduce its impact on the environment and the interior has been completely redesigned. The ice-strengthened hull allows us to venture further north than most other polar yachts, venturing into ice-packed areas, away from the crowds. With just 12 guests on board, every journey feels like a private luxury expedition.

The open-plan lounge provides comfortable seating with nearly 360° panoramic views, perfect for relaxation or attending lectures. Multiple observation decks offer excellent photography opportunities, while the bridge invites you to join the crew in scanning the horizon for wildlife. After an exhilarating day of exploration, feel free to unwind in the on-deck jacuzzi or sauna.

Accommodation options are thoughtfully designed for comfort and style. The upper deck features two Single Cabins and two Executive Suites. On the lower deck, you'll find two Superior Suites and three Deluxe Single Suites. All suites are furnished with the essential amenities. If you need additional items such as pillows or towels, don't hesitate to ask the crew.

Electrical power: All sockets are in European format. You will also find several USB sockets in your room. For Swiss or American passengers, adapters are available for the duration of your cruise. They must be returned on the last day of your trip.

Luggage storage: If you do not wish to store your suitcase under the bed, you can leave it with the staff who will store it elsewhere onboard.

Temperature control: The ship has central heating and it is possible to individually adjust the heating in your cabin.

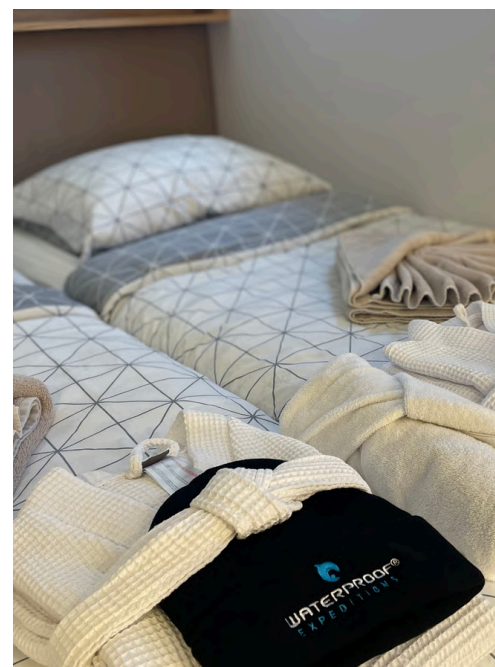
Bathroom: All rooms have private en-suite bathrooms. We offer shower products in eco-pump format to reduce plastic waste. All bathrooms are equipped with a heated towel rail.

Amenities: You will find a hair dryer, towels and bathrobes in your cabin.

Cleaning Service: Your cabin will be cleaned daily. Towels and bed sheets will be changed according to the duration of your trip. Please leave any towels you wish to have changed on the floor.

Laundry: There is no laundry service on board.

Sharing cabins: When two guests are sharing a cabin, the beds can be split up into twins (except for our Executive Suite).

Safety: The vessel is fitted with all necessary safety equipment. A safety briefing will be held before sailing and instructions can be found in each room.

Language: English is the primary language during our voyages.

Communications: WIFI is included onboard, allowing you to send messages or e-mails. However, the WIFI is not sufficient for sending/receiving large files. In the Arctic, you can sometimes use the local roaming networks when close to shore. The ship is also equipped with a satellite phone.

Crew: The Captain is the master on board. He is assisted by the First Officer, an engineer and two qualified sailors. The hospitality team is composed of a Chef and a steward(ess). The Expedition Leader is in charge of the programme, and is assisted by an expedition guide.

Main lounge: The 75m² lounge is divided into a conference room with large screen, dining area, a reading area and a bar. The 19 large windows ensure optimal views.

Meals: Mealtimes will be announced and can vary due to unexpected changes in the schedule. Breakfast and lunch are buffet style, dinners are served at the table. Please advise us of any dietary requirements and allergies so we can inform the chef.

Bar and accounts: Water, coffee and tea are included. Soft drinks, wine, beers, spirits, etc. are available at an extra charge.

Alcohol: It's not allowed to bring and consume your own alcohol on board.

Smoking: We have a non smoking policy onboard. If you are in urgent need to smoke please respect the wishes of non-smokers and ask for a specific smoking area onboard. Please never throw a cigarette into the sea.

Gratuities: The customary tip to the crew is usually made as a blanket contribution (preferably in cash) at the end of the voyage and is divided among the crew members. The amount you wish to give is at your own discretion.



Daily Programme: The programme will be announced by the expedition leader. The aim is to spend as much time outside as possible, but nature and the expedition leader ultimately make the final decision. You may spend some days on board the ship, while other days you have multiple outings. You are always free to participate or skip an activity.

Lectures: Daily lectures will be held by the guides about a whole range of polar related subjects. You are free to attend these lectures as you like.

Bridge visits: You are nearly always welcome on the bridge. Please remember that the bridge is a working place. When in port or during rough weather the bridge might be closed to visitors.

Wildlife: The guides and crew are constantly on the lookout for interesting wildlife. If animals have been spotted, this will be announced via the intercom system.

Polar Plunge: Depending on the weather conditions, you are likely to be offered to participate in a Polar Plunge!



Jacuzzi & Sauna: Use of the panoramic jacuzzi and sauna are included. If you wish to use them, please inform the staff so that they are at the right temperature.

Zodiacs: We have two zodiacs. Embarking the zodiacs from the ship is done via a gangway. There is space for all guests in the zodiacs at once.

Zodiac suits: Waterproof zodiac suits are available to keep you warm and dry during zodiac cruises.
